



Pre-Qualification of Consultants (National/International), and Equipment Suppliers For UNDP/GEF Wind Energy Project

United Nations Development Program (UNDP) has embarked on the project “Sustainable Development of Utility Scale Wind Power Production” referred to as Wind Energy Project (WEP). The project is being funded by Global Environment Facility (GEF) and implemented through Alternative Energy Development Board (AEDB Government of Pakistan. The first phase of the project will focus on creating enabling environment for the development of wind energy in Pakistan. The Wind Energy Project (WEP) facilitating Government of Pakistan in implementing recently introduced “Policy for the Development of Renewable Energy in Pakistan” will initially focus on following key areas:

- Institutional strengthening of relevant government and private sector institutions for sustainable development of wind power and other wind energy applications.
- Review of policy and tariff structure for renewable energy technologies specifically wind energy.
- Wind resource assessment of international standards.
- Indigenous manufacturing of wind turbine machinery.

4. List of projects completed (along with brief description of similar consultancies undertaken and those currently in progress), and joint ventures with international consultants. Name of clients, and major accomplishments.
5. Certificate of valid registration for 2006 with Pakistan Engineering Council.
6. Income Tax/Sales Tax Registration (NTN) of firms
